

Bayham contents gauges are of a modular construction with build options to suit a variety of applications including mobile tankers and locomotives. Side mounting and top mounting versions are available with material options to suit the fluid to be measured. Dial sizes from 50mm to 250mm can be supplied with either standard markings in fractions or with custom calibrated dials in engineering units to suit the tank size.

Gauges are available manufactured to suit particular service requirements or standard

stock gauges with adjustable length float arms and dials scaled in fractions can be supplied from stock.


Installation

The most common position to mount the gauge is half way up the side of the tank thus allowing the shortest float arm to be used. Any baffles or internal cross bracing should not interfere with the arc of the float arm travel. Please note that the size, number and position of the gauge flange mounting holes are different for each gauge. Dimensioned drawings are available on request.

We stock mounting pads pre-fitted with studs, nuts, and washers suitable for welding on to steel tanks.


